SAND COVE forced the pace, lapped on to the leader through the far turn, challenged in earnest at the top of the stretch, gained the lead then held under a drive. J J FOR DAVE led early, set a pressured pace, was headed upper stretch, chased and came up with a strong late effort but missed. LADY'S FIRST CAT, in touch early, chased hard angling from two to four-wide on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. AEOLUS raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn then finished gamely in vain. RACE FOR GOLD stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. VINNY'S VALLEY, rated off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then lacked a closing response. GUIPAGO, rated off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
