Footnotes

GAMBERONI settled well off the early pace, closed from last angling seven-wide late turn, bid upper stretch, gained command then held under a drive. MOLINARO FORT raced midpack, closed late turn, bid outside the leader six-wide at the top of the stretch, was outkicked by the winner but finished gamely. BLUSHING BRAT stalked the pace in hand, was hustled early turn but was blocked and in hand late turn then finished gamely. CALM NIGHT stalked the pace, chased hard with a strong move from early turn, had command late turn and drifted out five-wide, was engaged at the top of the stretch, battled briefly and gave way grudgingly. PERSONAL SIGNAL raced off the pace, was hustled late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. KHABIBULIN raced midpack, was hustled two and three-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. ALIMIN set a reserved pace, quickened on the turn, was collared late turn, chased briefly and tired upper stretch.
