Footnotes

NATALINA broke through the gate before the start, but was pulled up quickly and reloaded, was then allowed to settle just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and got up in the final strides after a long drive. FLASHY SILVER pressed the early pace outside of rivals, assumed command three wide in the drive and drew clear, but could not hold off the winner. IT'S ABOUT SILVER was slow early inside of rivals, moved to the outside in upper stretch and closed with a rush in the final furlong. LORI'S EXPECTATION pressed the early pace from the inside, drew even on the turn and dueled briefly, then tired in the drive and dropped back. SAUDI SADIE set the early pace in hand, dueled on the turn, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. PYRITE MENU was void of early speed outside of rivals and never a factor. ELUSIVE ASHLEE pressed the early pace between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. COUSIN CHARLOTTE was unhurried early off the rail and outrun.
