ONE FOR ROSE stalked from the third path, edged up outside the leader early backstretch, drew abreast at the 1/2 mile pole, edged clear on the far turn, came out approaching the stretch then finished best under strong encouragement. WINNING CHANCE rated early, stalked the pace from the fourth path, was asked to close on the far turn, was determined in the stretch, was blocked slightly in the late stages but just did not have enough. HANDPAINTED led quickly, set the pace, was under pressure on the backstretch, could not match strides with the winner on the far turn, chased to the stretch then evened out. MISS SANTA ANITA was always contentious while trailing, saved ground on the first turn and came through the far turn on the second path then lacked a strong closing response.
