SERIOUS INDEED led quickly, set a pressured pace from the rail, moved clear into the stretch then held sway under a light drive. BEAR'S TENOR, rated off the pace, chased late turn and was all out through the stretch. RIVER LEMON raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide through the turn then finished determinedly. THUNDERING WATERS settled off the pace, closed along the rail on the turn, chased into the stretch but was not a threat. BORN TO BOOGIE, off a step slowly, was rated off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. EVAC raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then lacked a closing response. GET A GRIP (IRE) forced the pace, chased into the stretch and tired.
