SUNDIN forced the pace on the backstretch, took the lead along the rail at the turn and moved clear then widened through the stretch under a drive. SPUR TREE raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. GOT YOU COVERED, taken back early, was hustled from off the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. GET THE PATIENCE settled off the pace, chased three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. FOUR ONE SIX showed brief speed, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch and flattened out. PALMETTO MOON stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. UNCLE BELLUM settled in midpack, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response.
