Footnotes

EBONY COUNTESS set the early pace inside of rivals, responded well in the drive and drew clear under intermittent urging. CAMPAIGN ANDOVER was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn and closed willingly well off the rail. RUBY TANGO was unhurried early inside of rivals, angled four wide in the drive and finished with a mild rally. IT'S SIENNA was off slowly, but closed the gap quickly in the backstretch to settle just off the lead, continued strong in the drive and finished evenly. SINHOUSE pressed the early pace outside of rivals, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. GAMBOLWITHDESTINY was void of early speed along the rail and never a factor. AMERICAN MARKET pressed the early pace between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. WAR RIVER showed little and was outrun.
