Footnotes

MARIA CLARISSA raced midpack, closed between foes upper stretch, rallied smartly and got up late. ALAYA stalked from the rail, launched an all out rally in the stretch, reached the fore in the late stages but missed. CHICK, close early, swung out leaving the turn, drew abreast of the leaders with a determined drive but failed to sustain the bid. SHOWSTOPPER closed along the rail late turn, finished gamely but needed more. HIGHLAND DEED stalked four-wide, was well-positioned at the top of the stretch but hung. MAGNIFICENTAPPROVAL led quickly, set the pace then tired in the final sixteenth. PSYCHEDELIA, in touch throughout while racing three-wide, was roused at the top of the stretch but hung. DANCING LEAVES raced midpack outside rivals, lacked a strong closing response. BONNIE CIELO stalked the pace from between horses then tired at the top of the stretch. CLASSIC ALLEY, always well off the pace, raced along the second path then lacked a rally. CABERNET FRANC trailed along the rail to late on the turn then passed tiring foes. TINAKILLY raced well

off the pace while three-wide and lacked a closing response. HASTINGS PRINCESS was always far back on the third path and never threatened. DAILY GRINDER saved ground from off the pace but lacked a rally.
