BIGASMAR pulled to the fore, dueled with two others, shook clear early turn then widened through the stretch under light handling. MAXIOM, in touch, closed five and six-wide on the turn then finished determinedly outside. CASUAL REWARD, in touch, chased five-wide late turn and finished all out. DANISH SPIRIT pulled to the front, dueled, on the backstretch, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch. BOXING RING stalked the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. DON DIEGO broke inward, raced off the pace then showed a mild late rally along the rail. JEST A GENIUS stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn but lacked a stretch response. BLONDESSILVERDREAM had outside speed, dueled on the backstretch, chased four-wide on the turn but tired upper stretch.
