HE'S ETAIN stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn, rallied, bid in deep stretch and prevailed, driving. WHERE'S THE BAY, bothered at the start, raced off the pace, was patient to late turn, rallied between foes but missed. OSCAR SHRUGS raced off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the turn then rallied late between horses. WE BEEN SPOTTED led early, shook clear on the turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to hold his rivals safe in deep stretch. BRIDGETOWN HARBOUR showed brief speed then forced the pace, chased four-wide on the turn but evened out in the late stages. PECK ON THE CHEEK stalked the pace, chased late turn then evened out along the rail in the stretch. GREEN FORESTER raced in midpack, chased four-wide late turn but failed to menace. YES THIS IS IT broke inward, raced well back, was hustled four-wide on the turn but was never a threat.
