CHEROKEE MEL was void of early speed off the rail, went between horses around the turn, came outside of the leaders in the drive and closed with a rush 4 wide getting up in the final strides. WORTHINGTON LASS was hustled along between horses and vied for the early lead, dueled in upper stretch with PERSUASIVE COPY, put that one away but could not hold off the winner. The latter was hustled along just off the rail, dueled in the drive but weakened at the end. GREYORGRAY stalked the early pace outside of rivals, stayed wide around the turn and finished with a mild rally in the stretch. GYPSY BELLE was unhurried early just off the rail but flattened out in the stretch. GRACEFUL SPIRIT was hustled along, vied for the early lead 3 wide then tired in stretch. ORIENTAL SELECT was in hand and saved ground but lacked a late response. REGAL PASS was hustled along between horses 3 wide then faded in the stretch.
