


**Footnotes**

NUCLEAR DEBATE was unhurried early inside of rivals, checked hard on the turn and was blocked in upper stretch, moved outside of JOE'S SON JOEY when that one jumped a shadow in the final furlong and assumed command under strong urging. JOE'S SON JOEY was in hand inside of rivals, split horses in upper stretch and assumed command, opened a clear lead in mid stretch but jumped a shadow in the final furlong and almost lost the rider giving up the lead. TEXAS GLITTER was in hand between horses three wide, angled four wide in the drive and closed willingly. NUMEROUS TIMES was taken back and allowed to settle between horses, closed the gap on the turn, but was blocked briefly, roused in upper stretch and closed the gap, then flattened out slightly in the final strides. AMAZON RIVER vied for the early lead between horses and held well. SAM LORD'S CASTLE was unhurried early between horses, checked at the three eighths pole and dropped back, then finished with a mild bid along the rail. SKY HUNTER vied for the early lead between horses, then weakened in upper stretch and dropped back. HOPTUIT BUD was slow early along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and finished with a mild rally. WAKE AT NOON was void of early speed, swung wide at the three eighths pole and passed tiring rivals. GONE FISHIN was unhurried early outside of rivals, raced widest on the turn and lacked a late response. KIMBERLITE PIPE was void of early speed four wide, came six wide entering the stretch and never rallied.

OLYMPIAN vied for the early lead inside of rivals, drew clear in upper stretch, but faltered with a furlong to go and faded. AIRBOURNE COMMAND was unhurried early four wide, swung seven wide entering the stretch and faded. MR. EPPERSON was rushed to contention from the outside and vied for the early lead four wide, then faded in the stretch.
