ROCK THE MOON raced off the pace, closed along the rail through the turn, angled three-wide approaching the top of the stretch, rallied and got up late under a drive. ATHENA ROSE, in range, was hustled along the rail on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, bested the early leader in deep stretch but was caught nearing the wire. REFUGIO raced midpack, closed five-wide late turn and finished determinedly. YANKEE CANDY set a pressured pace, dueled from the top of the stretch then gave way grudgingly. SWIMSWIMSWIM raced off the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn then rallied willingly outside. WONDERFULLY raced off the pace, was hustled two-wide late turn but failed to menace. SMART BRASS stalked close up to the leader, chased three and four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. FIRST AFLEET broke in the air, raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn then evened out in deep stretch. WANADAY raced well back, angled four to six-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally. SWEET COLLEEN raced midpack, closed on the far turn racing two and three-wide then lacked a closing response. BOOTIFUL forced the pace to the turn, backed away and lacked a closing response.
