Footnotes

CLEAR MARCH stalked the pace, was hustled angling four to six-wide on the far turn, lodged her bid at the top of the stretch, drove clear and widened under a strong hand ride. CHARISMATICALLY, well back early, chased five-wide on the far turn, challenged late turn, dueled, was passed upper stretch and chased the winner to the wire. BREEZE BAYOU stalked early then forced the pace on the far turn, bid late turn and dueled into the stretch, was passed upper stretch and flattened out. PARVATI stalked the pace, chased angling from two to five-wide on the far turn but lacked a serious stretch response. NUEVO DINERO was prominent outside JOPLIN from the outset, set a pressured pace from midbackstretch, was joined, dueled into the stretch and tired. BEBE AND HENRY, off slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn but never reached contention. JOPLIN was prominent on or forcing the early pace, failed to sustain her bid into the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
