Footnotes

OUR TRUE GAL settled off the pace, closed three then four-wide on the far turn, bid upper stretch and took a short lead then held SILENT PASSION safe under a drive. SILENT PASSION, away alertly, dueled on the clubhouse turn, forced the pace on the backstretch, rebid along the rail approaching the turn, took command early turn, was joined upper stretch and gave up a slight advantage but battled gamely to the wire. HONEY BREW stalked close up, chased three-wide on the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. LARGO VERDE settled off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the far turn but did not threaten. BUCK HUNTER settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. ZIPPITY ZIP dueled on the first turn, held a short lead under pressure on the backstretch, was headed early turn, chased two-wide then gave way.
