MR. EPPERSON was well rated inside of rivals stalking the early pace, edged off the rail in upper stretch wore down rivals getting up in the final strides after a long drive. AIRBOURNE COMMAND was well rated three wide just off the lead, did not respond in upper stretch and dropped back slightly, but surged in the final strides and got up for place. ALEA IACTA EST was allowed to settle off the rail in the early going, roused six wide on the turn and closed the gap in upper stretch, loomed boldly in the drive and finished well outside of rivals. HELIOTROPE was well rated inside of rivals, full of run on the turn and steadied repeatedly, split horses in upper stretch and closed willingly in the final furlong. SOLITARY DANCER was void of early speed in the two path, swung wide in upper stretch and finished with a late gain. TEXAS GLITTER sprinted to the early lead in hand, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, but stopped in the final seventy yards and faded. OLYMPIAN stalked the early pace between horses, but was blocked and steadied in the drive. CRUCIBLE was allowed to settle four wide, but failed to respond and was never a threat. IMPEACHABLE SIN was unhurried early in the three path and never rallied.
