SPEIGHTSTOWN was in hand outside of SARATOGA PRINCE just off his flank, drew even on the turn and assumed command entering the stretch, then drew clear under steady pressure. GRAND END SWEEP was void of early speed along the rail, roused on the turn and rallied while saving ground, came between horses in the final sixteenth and got up for place. CATAHOULA PARISH was allowed to settle off the rail in the early going, roused in the drive and finished with a mild rally outside of CATAHOULA PARISH. SARATOGA PRINCE gained a short lead in the backstretch and set the pace in hand, could not stay with the winner entering the stretch and dropped back in the final furlong. DAWSON'S LEGACY was void of early speed while saving ground and was never a threat. DEPUTY INXS raced in the middle of the pack well off the rail, failed to respond on the turn and dropped back in the drive. HIT THE ROAD BEAU stalked the early pace along the rail, but was pulled up after two furlongs.
