### Footnotes

PELLEGRINO (BRZ) raced midpack between horses, closed late turn, rallied three-wide and swept to the lead near the 1/8 pole then held under a drive. ROYAL CHALLENGER raced off the pace, angled from the rail to four-wide at the top of the stretch, rallied determinedly, was gaining steadily but missed. FRENCH BERET rated early up close along the rail, closed late turn, bid inside CRACKENTHORPE at the top of the stretch, vied, wore down that rival midstretch and led briefly but was no match for the winner and weakened grudgingly. LAST ANSWER, unhurried early, closed three or four-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. CRACKENTHORPE set a reserved pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly and yielded midstretch. SEXTET raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the final turn then lacked a closing response. COLD WAR, in range on the outside, dropped back early on the far turn and lacked a rally. TALL COOL ONE, always well back, saved ground but lacked a rally. GUILLAUME TELL (IRE) stalked the pace, was hustled on the far turn but faded between foes late turn.
