FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS, FOALED IN CANADA. Weight; Colts and Geldings 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs. By subscription of \$150 each to accompany the nomination by February 1st, 2007 (131 nominations); To continue eligibility the following additional payments must be made: Second subscription of \$1,500 by May 1st, 2007 (51 remained eligible) plus 5 supplements at \$5,000 each. An additional \$10,000 when making final entry no later than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 21, 2007. Horses not originally nominated may supplement at time of final entry for \$25,000 which includes the entry fee. Total purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. All monies received from the original nomination (February 1st, 2007) will be divided equally between the gross purses of the Queen's Plate, Prince of Wales and Breeders' Stakes. Final entries to be made through the entry box no later than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 21, 2007. \$300,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program plus up to \$27,600 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Daaher supplemented.



Footnotes

MIKE FOX stalked the pace three-wide to the far turn, was roused along the second path on the far turn, responded smartly in the final furlong and got up late. ALEZZANDRO led early, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn, had a clear lead in the stretch but weakened late. JIGGS COZ stalked three-wide, closed into the far turn, chased ALEZZANDRO to deep stretch then hung in the final 70 yards. DAAHER stalked along the rail, was flat on the far turn then found his best stride too late to menace. INCLUDE US, unhurried to the far turn, closed three-wide then evened out late. MARCHFIELD, in touch early while four-wide, was hustled three-wide through the far turn but evened out in the stretch. TWILIGHT METEOR pressed the pace from between foes, chased the leader on the final turn then flattened out. COBRADOR was rated off the early pace between foes, showed no response on the far turn and tired.
