MOUNTAIN ECHO unhurried in the early going, was between foes on the turn then rallied wide and between foes to prevail under good handling. GETTING BOLD vied inside and dueled on the turn, took the lead into mid stretch then was full out to save the place. SILVER PIZZAZZ outside and in the game, bid widest on the turn and through the stretch to finish well. GIGOLETTE tracked the leaders, was well off the rail into the stretch, bid between but was outgunned to the wire. CLASSY GEM off the pace then inside turning for home, needed a rail kick. FLOATING SKY forced the pace from the outside then weakened between foes in the drive. INSTINCTIVEAFLEET had a wide trip and then lacked the needed rally. VICTORIA CHARM trailed early and was never a factor.
