Footnotes

PADRAIG stalked the pace, chased up close on the far turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch, finished all out and got up late. KILLDARES PROSPECT, off slowly, settled off the pace, closed angling from three to seven-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly. SKY OF GREY pressed the pace, chased hard on the final turn, bid upper stretch, drove clear then failed to hold in the late stages. JOEY'S BEST, in range, bid into the far turn, was outfooted and forced the pace, rebid upper stretch, was outkicked and chased to the end. MARCELLINO raced off the pace, chased hard late turn and finished all out along the rail. NOT TOO TACKY broke outward, forced the pace, bid into the final turn, gained a short lead, was engaged at the head of the stretch and gave way. KING OF THE SWAMP led early, was headed at the far turn and faded.
