RIDING THE RIVER, rated off the pace, moved off the rail midturn, angled out and closed into the stretch, launched a furious rally six-wide, drew abreast a furlong out and prevailed under steady pressure. BIG BAND SOUND, prominent early, was headed and pressed the pace, stalked on the turn, rebid along the rail midstretch, gained a narrow advantage albeit briefly and was outfinished. HOLLINGER, rated in midpack, closed on the turn, launched an all out drive but missed. HOTHERSAL led midway of the backstretch, was headed at the turn, forced the issue three-wide, rebid upper stretch but quickly gave way. TREND stalked the pace two-wide, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. STORMY LORD moved up the rail to duel late backstretch, took a short lead into the turn, set a pressured pace, was caught upper stretch and tired.
