SPEED RIVER was allowed to settle between horses in the early going, came outside of the leader in the second turn and loomed boldly, was all out in the drive and assumed command in the final furlong after a long drive then drew clear in the final strides. SAUCY ANNA showed good early speed and set the pace in hand, held that lead to deep stretch before grudgingly giving way in the final strides. VICTORIAN DANCER was in hand stalking the early pace just off the rail then weakened in the stretch. H QUE was slow early, closed the gap between horses in the backstretch, raced three wide in the second turn and finished evenly. ADAGIO'S GEM was void of early speed off the rail, roused four wide in the second turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. T. J. MAGIC was allowed to settle inside of rivals and lacked a late response. ONE KNIGHT STAND pressed the early pace from the rail then tired in the second turn and dropped back. WIRBELWIND was fanned four wide in the first turn, raced close up in the backstretch then dropped back in the second turn and was pulled up entering the stretch.
