LUIGI'S HONOUR raced off the pace, closed six then seven-wide late turn, chased into the stretch, bid a sixteenth out and drove clear. GO GINGER GO raced off the pace, closed fast into the turn, bid midturn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but failed to contain the winner in the final sixteenth. BRICKYARD CROSSING moved up close early on the main track, was taken back to stalk the leader, angled from rail to four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. ZENKO forced the pace on the main track, bid early turn, vied to late turn and gave way. ACE IN MY POCKET, up close in hand, angled five-wide late turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. MOONDRIFTER raced off the pace, was roused six-wide late turn but failed to show a serious stretch response. HIGHLAND GYPSY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then tired upper stretch. MONASHEE DANCER sprinted clear early, was under pressure once on the main track, was joined at the turn, vied briefly, gave way midturn and faded.
