THE BOY'S RING stalked the pace battle in a good trip, bid outside in the stretch run and then took command and drew off. ASK THE BESTMAN pressed the pace from the outside, dueled into and through the turn then failed to match the winner in the drive. WHERE'S THE FIRE off the pace from mid pack, had a wide stretch bid and was up for the show. COOK'S LOOK in striking distance and a factor on the turn, evened out. ACCOMPLICE bumped at the break, raced wide and was not a threat. ACED THE MOVES in mid pack, was wide turning for home then lacked the needed bid. MR. TURNABOUT raced far back and never did menace. COLONEL BE GOOD showed little while racing well back in the early going. MORETHANCONQUERORS wide into the stretch, was not a factor at any time. KEVIN RAWKS dueled inside of rival and was in the tussle into the stretch then faltered.
