TU ENDIE WEI raced midpack, chased seven-wide late turn, came with a rush and swept to the lead in the final furlong and finished under a hand ride. RUNFOR RO raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, finished full of run zig zagging between rivals in the stretch. SAMSAL raced

midpack, came three to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. ROSE AND SHINE was hustled from off the pace, angled six-wide late turn and finished gamely. SILVER SILHOUETTE raced off the pace, came three to seven-wide through the turn then tendered a mild rally outside. HOPE FOR A WIN sprinted to the early lead, set a rapid pace, was passed just into the final furlong and tired with no chase left in her. HENNY'S HEART raced midpack between foes, chased three to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. TIP YOUR HAT raced midpack, was hustled three-wide then flattened out in the final furlong. MORE THAN MINTED chased in range, came two to five-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. PLUS ONE chased from the outset, backed away late turn and had no stretch response. SINGING IN KEY chased in range on the backstretch but was through by late turn. EUPHRASIA bumped with a rival at the start and was through by the turn. CATCHING REYS stumbled at the start, was always off the pace and lacked a rally. BEWITCHING LADY bumped with EUPHRASIA at the start, raced in range but faded from midturn.
