Footnotes

ELUSIVE A. C. dueled from the rail, drifted out late turn then drew clear at the top of the stretch and widened under a drive. ONE SIXTY was well back early, then closed steadily between rivals. MI'AN MAR dueled outside ELUSIVE A.C., was forced out slightly late turn then tired at the top of the stretch. DASHFORTHROSES raced midpack, closed steadily four-wide and finished best of the rest. SPLENDIFEROUS ONE raced four-wide in the middle of the pack, was steadied when bothered by the spill in deep stretch and did not menace. VICTORIAN DAMASK was close early on the rail, lacked a rally and was steadied when bothered in deep stretch by fallen horses. FLASHY GAL trailed the field from the fourth path and was bothered in the late stages by the spill and was steadied. GLADIATORS CONSORT always far back on the second path, was steadied when bothered by the spill in front of her at the 70 yard

pole. KALOOKAN CODE raced midpack along the rail, lacked a rally and was steadied in deep stretch. GOOD FOR US was always far back,saved ground then steadied behind a spill in the late stages. IMAGINARY IMAGE stalked the pace from the rail, was under a drive in deep stretch when she took a bad step and fell at the 70 yard pole. AT THE OFFICE raced on the second path while in striking range but fell over an already downed horse at the 70 yard pole. AFTER REVIEWING THE STRETCH RUN THE STEWARDS DID NOT CHANGE THE ORDER OF FINISH.
