THE ONE-HUNDRED AND FORTY-SIXTH RUNNING OF THE QUEEN'S PLATE, FIRST JEWEL IN CANADA'S TRIPLE CROWN SERIES. Purse \$1,000,000 Guaranteed. (Plus Fifty Guineas, the Gift of Her Majesty the Queen.) Purse \$1,000,000 Guaranteed. For THREE-YEAR-OLDS, FOALED IN CANADA. Weight; Colts and Geldings 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs. By subscription of \$150 each to accompany the nomination by February 1st, 2004 (371 nominations); second subscription of \$500 by February 1st, 2005 (168 remained eligible, plus 5 supplements at \$7,500 each); third subscription of \$1,000 by May 15th, 2005(48 remained eligible, plus 5 supplements at \$15,000 each); and an additional \$10,000 when making final entry no later than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 23, 2005. Horses not originally nominated maybe made eligible by payment of a late nomination fee of \$7,500 on or before February 1st, 2005 or of \$15,000 on or before May 15th, 2005. Total purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. All monies received from the original nomination (February 1st, 2004) and the February 1st, 2005, payments will be divided equally between the gross purses of the Queen's Plate, Prince of Wales and Breeders' Stakes.

Footnotes

WILD DESERT rated early in touch with the front runner, closed two-deep late turn, was squeezed by GOLD STRIKE a furlong out then drove to the lead with 70 yards to run. KING OF JAZZ rated early, closed three-deep late turn, bid a furlong out and gained a slight lead but failed to stave off the winner in deep stretch. GOLD STRIKE raced forwardly outside GRANIQUE, moved clear midbackstretch, set a reserved pace and was still in hand on the far turn, was under urging from the top of the stretch, came out near the 1/8 pole bothering WILD DESERT and tired. MOLINARO BEAU, taken in hand right from the start, remained unhurried on the rail then rallied belatedly. ABLO, in touch between horses, was set down late turn but flattened out in the stretch. GRANIQUE raced forwardly inside GOLD STRIKE, settled on the backstretch, stalked the pace, was squeezed back a bit along the rail leaving the turn and lacked a late response. DANCE WITH RAVENS raced from off the pace four and five-wide, made a slight move at the top of the stretch then flattened out. GET DOWN stalked from the outside, faded on the far turn and tired. THREE IN THE BAG rated three-deep, was roused four-wide late turn then had no

response when asked.
