BEAR REINDEER led on the first turn, set a reserved pace, moved clear midway of the backstretch, had command through the turn then was kept to business in the stretch. RAINBOW MISCHIEF, in range, was hustled from early on the far turn, chased in the stretch, failed to close the gap late but held 2nd. REDEPLOY, rated early, closed late backstretch, angled four to six-wide through the turn then finished all out late between foes. RIP 'EM UP raced off the pace, closed late backstretch, circled chasing five to seven-wide late turn then evened out in the final furlong. DICK WHITTINGTON, up close early, was patient behind rivals along the second path late turn then finished evenly. DEPUTY LOR, in range, chased late turn while angling from the third to the fifth path then lacked a closing response. WORKING MAN BLUES forced the pace, was hustled late turn but tired upper stretch. TEO broke outward, raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but lacked a stretch response.
