SLAVENSKA moved to the rail early on the backstretch and raced well off the pace, closed inside rivals late turn, responded to encouragement upper stretch, rallied and was up in the final 16th. LUNAR LINDA stalked the pace from the rail and was still in range two-wide late turn, was under urging but hung midstretch but finally dug in late and got up for 2nd. DESIRE AND FIRE led midway of the backstretch, quickened on the turn, was all out through the stretch but weakened late. SWAMP PATROL had brief speed, settled and stalked from the rail, was hustled late turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. SPANISH DEPUTY settled well back early, was hustled five-wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. GO JUICE raced midpack, came four then five-wide through the turn, was roused upper stretch and finished gamely in vain. A KNIGHTS HEART, in range, raced three to five-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. ARTICULATING pulled to the lead and was under severe restraint, was headed early on the backstretch, settled and pressed the pacesetter on the turn, chased four-wide into the stretch then flattened out late. INTERREGNUM raced midpack early, dropped back on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive but evened out. JOHNNY'S CON stalked the pace racing from the second to fourth path through the turn, chased in the stretch but tired a furlong out. DARLIN DASHER, in range early, angled from two to five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. GO WEST G T GO, well back early, was hustled late turn but lacked a response in the stretch.
