MISSISSIPPI HIPPIE, away alertly, set a reserved pace, was hustled upper stretch then held sway under a hand ride. A P VALOR, in touch, stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn and finished gamely in vain. GOLDY SONG, in touch early, raced midpack into the turn, was hustled along then rallied gamely. KWIK COSTA, in touch between rivals, angled from four to six-wide late turn and finished willingly. WILBERFORCE pressed the pace early, chased three-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive but flattened out midstretch. FORBIDDEN DREAMS raced midpack, angled seven-wide late turn then tendered a mild late rally. SLEW'S KID pressed the early pace, dropped back nearing the turn, saved ground and improved position but flattened out upper stretch but flattened out in the late stages. ZAP IT pressed the pace, chased hard three-wide late turn then tired upper stretch. BRUNNERA, in range, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then tired a furlong out. CONISTON settled well back, trailed the field to the stretch and was never a factor.
