TOWN PRIZE led quickly, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch then held sway under a strong hand ride. THE BEAR VOW chased from the rail, was boxed in midturn, chased into the stretch and rallied determinedly. SOLO PLAYER, up close outside rivals, forced the issue late turn but evened out in the late stages. FINALLY FRIENDS raced off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. CHANGE MY MIND raced off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to three-wide on the turn then tendered a mild late rally. BEAR'S TAURUS bumped with a rival at the outset, chased three and four-wide from off the pace on the turn then evened out late. HEZA ROMANTIC pressed the early pace, chased from between foes on the turn then evened out along the rail through the stretch. PLAYIN'INMYWHISKEY, bumped at the start, chased from midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn and tired in the late stages.
