GUEST APPEARING was sent to a brief lead, was headed at the first turn and pressed the leader, took command into the far turn, set a brisk pace and held sway under steady pressure through the stretch. CARDIAC REHAB raced off the pace, circled three to six-wide on the far turn and finished under an all out drive. OPENING MEET, in range, chased two-wide late turn and finished determinedly. BON JOVI'S SKY raced midpack, was hustled between foes late turn then rallied belatedly. RIBOT SUN, in range, came four-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. CROWN'S PATH stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide on the far turn then flattened out in deep stretch. PSYCHOTHERAPY stumbled at the start, raced in touch with the leaders, closed between foes on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. WOOKINWICKED trailed early, closed late backstretch and angled from three to six-wide on the far turn then flattened out. SCARLET'S DIAMOND raced off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to three-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. OIL BE CLEVER broke outward, raced in midpack, chased into the stretch but lacked a rally. HIDDEN PROFIT led into the

first turn, set a pressured pace, was headed approaching the far turn, chased hard to the stretch and tired. WIDMO raced midpack, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. NORTHERN STORE raced off the pace, was tiring late turn and steadied behind horses and was through. KING NAIVE broke outward, raced well off the pace, was hustled on the far turn and tired.
