### Footnotes

DALAVIN off a step slowly, remained unhurried to the turn, closed four-wide approaching the top of the stretch, took command and drew off under light handling. BURST OF FIRE stalked from the inside, bid along the rail entering the turn, dueled to the stretch and bested BACHELOR BLUES but was no match for the winner. BACHELOR BLUES steadied at the outset, sprinted to the early lead, set the pace to the turn then dueled outside BURST OF FIRE and gave way grudgingly to that one in the stretch. WITNESS THIS stalked from the third path, was blocked at the top of the stretch then evened out. LONE ARROW raced well off the pace, came three-wide through the turn and tendered a mild late response. ST REGS (IRE) stalked the pace from between rivals, came three-deep through the turn and flattened out in the stretch. MYNAVIGATOR well back between rivals, lacked a rally. MILLFLEET stalked from the rail but faded on the turn.
