DANCE FOR US, rated early, closed quickly between horses into the far turn, stalked briefly then pulled the trigger and angled out sharply late turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, gained a narrow advantage a sixteenth out and held that margin to the wire under steady handling. FLASHY GOT EVEN raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn, launched her bid at the top of the stretch, hung briefly but responded to urging and challenged late but was outfinished. HIGH MIST set a pressured pace, dueled on the final turn then yielded grudgingly midstretch. POLITELYPRECOCIOUS pressed the pace on the backstretch, bid into the turn, dueled to the final furlong and weakened. DOUBLE MALT stalked early then settled off the pace, was hustled from the third to the fifth path through the far turn then finished gamely to no avail. RETRACEABLE, rated off the pace, was hustled late turn but lacked the necessary rally. DANCING CHARM, close early, settled in range on the backstretch, stalked then was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn then tired approaching the stretch. ASTROTIME was in touch to the far turn, faded under a ride and showed not stretch response.
