Footnotes

DRESSED FOR ACTION set a pressured pace inside ELUSIVE THOUGHT, came off the rail into the stretch, drew clear in upper stretch, bumped with MISS CRISSY late, and held on gamely. MISS CRISSY bumped at the start, stalked the forced pace three wide, came four wide in the stretch, was hit with a rival's whip between the three sixteenths pole and eighth pole, bumped with DEE'S LOVE at the eighth pole, lugged in between the eighth and sixteenth pole while gaining, bumped with the winner late and just missed. TAMARA bumped at the start, raced three wide, advanced on the turn, rallied five wide in the stretch. SPEAK OUT was well placed inside, came three wide into the stretch, rallied while drifting in, and was outfinished for show. DEE'S LOVE stalked the forced pace from off the rail, made a three wide bid in upper stretch, bumped with MISS CRISSY at the eighth pole, was shut off by that one and checked between the eighth and sixteenth pole, and provided no further threat. ELUSIVE THOUGHT bore in shortly after the start, had a short lead early, pressed the pace outside the winner, gave way in upper stretch. TEEWEE'S HOPE was inside, and showed little. GLADIATOR'S DRIFT stalked the forced pace from the inside, dropped back on the turn. MISS SANTA ANITA was bumped and steadied at the start, trailed early while off the rail, and was not a threat. The rider of DEE'S LOVE claimed foul against the rider of MISS CRISSY. There was also a Stewards' inquiry looking into the stretch. After reviewing the films the Stewards ruled that MISS CRISSY being hit by the whip of DEE'S LOVE'S rider, and her lugging in and shutting off DEE'S LOVE offset another, thus there was no change to the order of finish.
