**Footnotes**

ARCHIE'S GAL led quickly, set the pace under pressure from PASSAGE ROAD, quickened on the far turn and widened under a drive. WISHBONE KID stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the far turn, came in upper stretch then finished with a strong late effort to gain the place. WHISKY SWISH, off a step slow, closed along the rail late turn, was all out in the stretch but hung late. DIAMON SU, unhurried early, raced just off the rail and never reached contention. PASSAGE ROAD, off a step slow, forced the issue, chased on the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. STEP ASIDE PLEASE was unhurried early along the rail then lacked a rally.
