MUTUAL AFFAIR was unhurried early, angled off the rail late turn, came six wide into the stretch, came in upper stretch and closed off LARRY'S SMILE but finished determinedly, gaining command in the final furlong. GLADIATOR QUEEN stalked the pace from the rail, launched an all out bid midstretch, was game but was no match for the winner in the final furlong. CYPRIATA broke alertly, led briefly then settled, bid inside WOODEN SHIPS entering the turn, dueled then took the lead at the top of the stretch but weakened a furlong out. LARRY'S SMILE stalked from between foes, swung five-wide at the top of the stretch, was closed off by MUTUAL AFFAIR then responded gamely and rallied albeit mildly. CATCH A FIRE stalked the pace, bid three-deep midturn, dueled to the top of the stretch then chased the leader briefly and tired. NOMISTAKEABOUTIT, always in touch, bid four-wide midturn, vied to the stretch and tired. WOODEN SHIPS held a short lead on the backstretch, was engaged entering the turn, vied to the top of the stretch and tired.
