Footnotes

TOWNCAT, always in range, closed four-wide late turn, bid midstretch and drove clear in the late stages. MAQUINA, off a step slowly, settled in midpack, was hustled on the turn, bid a furlong out, gained command but failed to hold in deep stretch. KIPS CALERO forced the pace, chased into the stretch, launched his bid but failed to sustain the drive. BIG HEAD RED broke outward, dueled on the backstretch, gained a short lead, set a pressured pace on the turn but gave way grudgingly a furlong out. FRANKIE'S BAD BOY dueled, was headed at the turn, forced the issue and chased hard into the stretch but flattened out. PLEASANT ROAD settled off the pace, angled three to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. NACHO EARL settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally. CAROLING MIA, off slowly, raced off the pace, chased on the turn but had no response in the stretch.
