EXTREMIST settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, rallied, bid in the final 16th and drew clear under a drive. KIAMA stalked the pace, closed in hand late turn, took command at the top of the stretch then failed to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. MUTTAK BAY dueled from midway of the backstretch, gained a short lead and set a pressured pace on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way. ANNELLE dueled from midbackstretch, forced the pace on the turn then evened out in the stretch. LADY GEEGEE, well back early, was hustled along the second path through the turn but never reached contention. MAXINE'S PRIDE raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but failed to menace. E. Z. IRISH raced off the pace, chased along the rail on the turn then tired in the final furlong.
