BIG DADDY BILL, rated well back early, closed on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch, drew off and finished well in hand. MAIL ORDER GROOM, well back early, was hustled three-wide on the far turn and finished best of the rest. DYNA BEAR stalked the pace, led into the far turn, was challenged at the top of the stretch but was no match and tired. TIZZY FAST stalked the pace, chased two-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. MIGHTY QUINN, off slowly, settled in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch. MOON OVER L. A., off slowly, raced in midpack, tired at the far turn, showed no response when roused and was eased in the stretch, finished the race and walked off. SCRAM ITS THE HAWK pulled to the lead, was under strong restraint and his saddle slipped early on the backstretch, was eased, picked up by the outrider in the stretch and walked off.
