**Footnotes**

AMAZONIAN RACEKEY stalked the early pace inside of rivals, slipped through entering the far turn and drew even, shook loose in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. SWISS DANCER was allowed to settle just off the rail, drew even at the three eighths pole, but could not stay with the winner in the drive and just lasted for place. QUEEN'S BELIEVER was unhurried in the middle of the pack then finished with a mild bid off the rail. ERINSVILLE raced well off the early pace inside of rivals, angled out in the second turn and passed tiring rivals in the drive. MAGIC FLARE stalked the early pace between horses, but lacked a strong response in the drive while running evenly. RICHLI INFLATED was in hand dueling for the early lead, opened a length advantage in the backstretch, but faltered in the second turn and dropped back. SEXIE KITTEN trailed for six furlongs before passing a few horses in the late going. COME BY CHANCE showed no speed and was never a factor. FAITH ALIVE was rushed to contention from between horses, pressed the pace in the backstretch then tired and faded. SCOTCH AND CANDY was void of early speed, started a rally four wide in the second turn, but broke down and fell approaching the quarter pole.
