ESPORON raced midpack, chased three and four-wide on the turn, rallied determinedly and got by late, driving. FASTIN BEAR set a pressured pace, was all out through the stretch but failed to hold in the late stages. BEAR STAR settled midpack, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch but evened out late. BOADINI stalked along the inside, was hustled late backstretch, chased on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. MECKE B KING, well back early, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. WHAT A PRINCE showed speed and forced the issue but tired a furlong out. PHINEAS raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. PERFECT CREVASSE raced off the pace, was hustled through the turn then lacked a rally.
