STEP ON UP, in touch, chased five-wide into the stretch, gained steadily and was just up in time under a drive. MARCO BE GOOD showed brief speed then stalked the pace, bid four-wide midturn, dueled and gained the lead upper stretch, held gamely to the late stages then failed to contain the winner at the wire. CAPTAIN RAUCOUS settled well off the early pace, was hustled on the turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then rallied outside. ROCKERFELLER raced midpack, chased late turn and finished under a determined drive. PUT UPON dueled early, edged ahead and led into the turn, was joined midturn, vied, then gave way grudgingly in the stretch. COUNTER MOVE raced off the pace from outside rivals, closed five and six-wide on the turn but lacked a strong closing response. RUMBLING CLOUD pulled early, dueled, was headed at the turn, rebid midturn, vied to the stretch and tired. WHISKEYONTHEROCKS, in touch along the rail, chased into the stretch but tired a furlong out.
