Footnotes

AIR BLADE, off slowly, closed on the backstretch, bid late turn, dueled, was headed midstretch but dug in and just got up under a drive. HOLY WHIRL WIND showed brief speed, stalked the pace, moved outside the leader leaving the backstretch, edged ahead early turn, was joined late turn, dueled into the stretch, gained a narrow advantage but yielded near the wire. IMPETUOUS ACT raced in midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly between rivals. GLOBAL EXPRESS raced off the pace, came three to five-wide through the far turn and rallied outside. TRADE RUMOR settled in midpack, chased on the far turn then finished all out along the rail. GOLDEN RIVET, off slowly, was kept in range, pressed the pace on the backstretch, bid late turn but gave way at the top of the stretch. GRENFELL settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn but lacked a closing response. BLUECAM broke in the air, took command on the clubhouse turn, set a reserved pace, was headed early on the far turn and faded. BIG SHOOTER, taken well back early, was hustled on the far turn but never reached contention.
