MT. SASSAFRAS stalked the early pace along the rail, closed the gap around the turn and assumed command along the rail in the 2nd turn then drew clear in the drive under intermittent urging. BRITE ADAM was pinched back at the start and trailed to the first turn, settled off the rail, went between horses in the 2nd turn, moved to the rail at the 1/4 pole and finished with a late gain. SKI MAKER settled in the second flight 3 wide, moved close up in the 2nd turn but flattened out in the drive. GOLD STAR DEPUTY vied for the early lead just off the rail then gave way in the 2nd turn and dropped back. SUNSHINE JOURNEY was void of early speed, roused 4 wide in the 2nd turn and finished with a mild bid. ZACHAROV was unhurried early off the rail, went 4 wide in the 2nd turn but was never a threat. THE FED was void of early speed between horses then passed tiring rivals in the drive. STEPHANOTIS vied for the early lead between horses then weakened in the 2nd turn and dropped back. NORTHERN SKY was 4 wide around the first turn and vied for the lead then faded in the stretch. SILVER TALK was checked between horses in the early going, settled in the second flight between horses but lacked a late rally.
