Footnotes

UPROAR broke sharply, but yielded to the early pace and settled outside of rivals, closed the gap in the turn and loomed boldly in upper stretch, switched to left handed urging and got up in the final strides after a log drive. TORRID AFFAIR sprinted to the early lead, drew clear in the turn and held that advantage to deep stretch, but weakened in the final strides and just failed. HEAT IT UP bore out at the start and bumped with CRUEL DAWN, trailed to the far turn, then roused between horses and closed willingly in the drive just off the rail. The latter was shut off at the start and dropped back, roused three wide in the turn and finished with a mild rally. GRASSA DONNA was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses then tired. REGALCLASS was hustled along outside of rivals, went three wide in the turn and lacked a late response. NATIONOFLITIGATION was void of early speed, saved ground to the turn, went between horses at the quarter pole, but was never a factor. DESERT D'OR was hustled along inside of rivals then tired in the turn and dropped back. DYNAMIC GIRL chased the early leader going three wide, then faded in the turn. There was a Stewards inquiry following the race for possible interference at the break. Also the jockey of CRUEL DAWN lodged a claim of foul against the jockey of HEAT IT UP for possible interference at the break. After reviewing the tapes, HEAT IT UP was disqualified from third position and placed fourth for interfering with CRUEL DAWN at the start.
