Footnotes

PHANTOM LIGHT had speed under pressure while three wide the first time through the stretch, cleared on the first turn, raced off the rail through the backstretch, was roused in upper stretch and began to draw off, received two left handed taps of the whip in mid stretch, then was under a strong hand ride to the wire. CHANGEINTHEWEATHER was off the rail while between horses, began to rally early on the second turn, and split horses just before the quarter pole, finished well four wide through the stretch to take the place position. DANCE TO DESTINY bobbed at the start, stalked the pace three wide, came under left handed urging on the second turn, was outfinished for the place position late. NO COMPRENDE trailed while off the rail, rallied three wide, split horses into the stretch, and continued the gain mildly through the stretch from off the rail. ATTEST raced three wide, advanced mildly four wide on the second turn and in the stretch. FLORIDA RECOUNT was well placed off the rail. DREAM LAUNCHER stalked the pace three wide, and was not a threat. UNBRIDLED VISION raced off the rail, and was not a factor. INDY LEAD stalked the pace five wide, weakened on the second turn. KISS A NATIVE advanced early to press the pace five wide the first time through the stretch, stalked the pace four wide on the first turn and early in the backstretch, came under right handed urging midway through the backstretch, and faded.
