Footnotes

MOBIL stalked the pace, closed three-wide and bid outside two others midturn, edged clear late turn and drew off in the stretch under light handling. MARK ONE was unhurried to the far turn then closed between horses and was all out in the stretch. THE JUDGE SEZ WHO was devoid of speed, trailed to the far turn then closed four-wide, was roused at the top of the stretch and was all out in the stretch. PARROTT BAY stalked from the rail, fell back on the far turn then angled out at the top of the stretch and failed to menace. HYDROGEN was well back, closed mildly three-deep late turn then hung in the stretch. TACKLING STRESS broke alertly, settled, stalked the pace then bid between foes on the far turn, was no match for MOBIL and tired at the head of the stretch. SLIM DUSTY led early, set the pace to midway of the final turn, yielded when challenged and was through.
