Non-winners of a Grade 1 race at a mile or over in 2005-2006 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Grade II race at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 5 lbs.; Of a Grade III race at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 9 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 11 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$4,000, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$12,420 Ontario Sire/Ontario BredBreeder Awards. Closed Wednesday, June 14, 2006 with 16 nominations.

FUNNY CIDE showed early speed in hand, led into the first turn, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn, turned back a challenge from CRYPTOGRAPH in the stretch, driving clear with a strong late effort. NOLAN'S CAT, unhurried to the far turn, angled out while closing on the far turn and rallied willingly. CRYPTOGRAPH stalked three-wide, launched his bid late turn, drew abreast of the leader at the top of the stretch but yielded in the late stages. SCIPION raced off the pace while saving ground, angled out while closing on the far turn, hit full stride three-wide at the top of the stretch but evened out in the final sixteenth. ARCH HALL stalked from the rail, was hustled late turn then flattened out. JUST IN CASE JIMMY trailed to the stretch, saved ground but never reached contention. SUMMER BOOK showed brief speed running alongside FUNNY CIDE past the grandstand, settled and stalked three-wide, kept in touch to the far turn and tired.
